An initial x-ray of Rosie's stomach was performed, but nothing appeared, so Rosie was sent home.

But when Rosie returned to the vet two days later with the same symptoms, her vet quickly realised more extensive x-rays were needed. When the second x-rays finally showed a foreign body lodged in Rosie's throat, her vet acted quickly.

Emergency surgery was performed, and a bottle cap was removed. She then spent three days recovering in ICU with antibiotics and pain killers. After improving quickly, Rosie was then released so her owners could continue her recovery at home.
